* Pay settlement of lawsuit by Marlene Acosta de Cubias in the sum of \$70,000 involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

ORDINANCE No.

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Marlene Acosta de Cubias, through attorney Marie Ballon, has filed a lawsuit against the City for compensation for bodily injuries suffered in a pedestrian/vehicle collision at SE 102nd Avenue and E. Burnside on December 30, 2015.
- The allegations in the lawsuit have been investigated by Risk Management and the City Attorney's Office. In order to avoid additional litigation expenses and the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to settle this lawsuit.
- 3. Risk Management and the City Attorney's Office recommend the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$70,000, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$70,000 made payable to Marlene Acosta de Cubias and Southwest Legal Group.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute payment authorizations in the amounts set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
