## ORDINANCE NO. 189313

\* Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services to execute special appropriation grant agreements (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services' Grants Management Division administers and manages the competitive and noncompetitive special appropriation grants awarded to grantees by the City of Portland.
- 2. Funding for special appropriations programs are included in the fiscal year adopted budget and budget monitoring process.
- 3. Currently, a report is made to Council regarding organizations awarded competitive special appropriations funding prior to establishing grant agreements between each organization and the City of Portland.
- 4. Currently, an ordinance is required for each special appropriations grant funded through the budget process. Doing an ordinance for each special appropriation grant significantly increases the time it takes for an grant agreement to become a fully executed document.
- 5. Currently, the Mayor must sign each special appropriation grant agreement after the ordinance is passed by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services is authorized to execute special appropriations grant agreements and special appropriations grant amendments, including amendments that increase the City's funding obligations, when Council, by ordinance, expressly allocates grant funding for the grantee in the City's budget.

Section 2. Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay could interrupt scheduled public services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
