## ORDINANCE No. 189316

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for safety improvements on US30BY (N Lombard) at N Greeley, N Newman, N Washburn, and N Fenwick (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- In February 2010, City Council adopted the Bicycle Plan for 2030, which
  designated N Concord Ave and N Fenwick Ave as City Bikeways and included
  Project 8178, a neighborhood greenway that includes a crossing from N Concord
  Ave to N Fenwick Ave across N Lombard St.
- The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) included in the Draft 2018 to 2021 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) a potential project to reconstruct multiple traffic signals along N Lombard St (a state-owned facility) from N Fiske Ave to N Fenwick Ave.
- 3. PBOT and ODOT have mutually agreed that the signal reconstruction project at N Lombard St & N Fenwick Ave should be designed with a two-way bikeway on the south side of Lombard to enable a safe crossing for pedestrians and bicyclists in both directions using the Concord/Fenwick Neighborhood Greenway.
- 4. PBOT and ODOT have mutually determined that the N Lombard St & Fenwick Ave project should be constructed by PBOT because it would provide substantial benefit to PBOT's pedestrian and bicycle network.
- 5. PBOT has worked with ODOT to ensure that the remaining ODOT STIP project, consisting of traffic signal reconstruction and safety improvements on N Lombard St from N Fiske Ave to N Wilbur Ave, includes pedestrian crossing studies at two locations (N Newman Ave and N Washburn Ave) as well as a truck apron at N Lombard St & Greeley Ave to improve pedestrian safety.
- 6. In October 2017, City Council adopted the Transportation System Development Charge (TSDC) Update, which includes Project 30037, N/NE Lombard Corridor Improvements, Phase 1.
- 7. PBOT has approved \$2,000,000 in TSDC funding for N Lombard St improvements, including funding for the N Lombard St & Fenwick Ave intersection improvements, the two pedestrian crossing studies, and the truck apron.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the City, through its Bureau of Transportation, is authorized to enter an IGA substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, under which PBOT will provide reimbursement to ODOT for pedestrian studies on N Lombard at two intersections (N Newman and N Washburn), and for ODOT to construct a truck turning apron on N Lombard at N Greeley, and that PBOT will construct crossing improvements on N Lombard at N Fenwick using transportation system development charges;
- b. The Director of PBOT may approve changes to the IGA if such changes, in the option of the Director in consultation with General Counsel, do not materially change the City's obligations or risks; and

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt ODOT's construction schedule and also impact PBOT's completion date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
