

ORDINANCE NO. 189318

* Authorize Portland Bureau of Emergency Management application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for a Pre-Disaster Mitigation grant in the amount of \$150,000 for an update to the 2016 Mitigation Action Plan (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provides hazard mitigation grant funding to reduce risk in local communities. The Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) grant provides funding to update mitigation plans, such as Portland's Mitigation Action Plan.
2. FEMA requires an approved mitigation plan to be eligible for mitigation grant funding. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management requires an approved mitigation plan to be eligible for Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) funding. Portland's mitigation plan, maintained by the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM), will expire in 2021.
3. Local match in the amount of \$50,000 for the PDM grant will be provided in the form of salary and benefits from participating staff across bureaus in FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-2021.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:


- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for a PDM grant in the amount of \$150,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the PDM grant application must be submitted no later than January 4, 2019. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
