ORDINANCE NO. 189339

*Authorize application to the Bullitt Foundation for a grant in the amount of \$50,000 as part of the Portland Climate Action Plan 2020 Update Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Climate Action Plan (CAP) Program of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability seeks to apply for a grant from the Bullitt Foundation.
- 2. Last updated in 2015, a review and update of the CAP is required to ensure Portland's progress in achieving adopted climate goals.
- The grant will fund robust engagement with culturally-specific community-based organizations and other community members that are leading on climate action initiatives to help create an updated CAP.
- 4. Funds requested from the Bullitt Foundation for this grant total \$50,000 for a period of one year and will go towards community engagement.
- 5. A match is not required by the Bullitt Foundation; however, the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability proposes in-kind support in form of existing community engagement staff resources and a facilitated workshop to that builds the capacity for City staff and community members to cocreate shared equity goals and work processes that are essential to achieving CAP goals and objectives.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability has permission to apply to the Bullitt Foundation for a grant in the amount of \$50,000, in a form substantially similar with the form attached as Exhibit A: Overview of Bullitt Grant Proposal Questions.
- b. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so that the City can meet the timelines in the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
