Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This Ordinance would allow the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability to submit a grant application to the Bullitt Foundation. The grant is in the amount of \$50,000. Work under this grant will focus on building capacity for City staff and under-served community partners to create aligned goals and priorities for the Portland Climate Action Plan 2020 Update. Last updated in 2015, review and update of the CAP is required in order to achieve the vision, goals and objectives of the adopted 2015 Portland Climate Action Plan.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

No City match is required, and no additional expenses will be incurred by this action.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The 2015 Portland Climate Plan is a product of extensive community engagement, including deep engagement with communities of color and low-income populations, and City Council adopted this version of the CAP in 2015. Greater alignment of CAP actions with priorities of low-income populations and communities of color in Portland will enable benefits of the City's climate action work to be shared more equitably with low-income communities and communities of color in Portland.
