Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The proposed legislation seeks to implement the Campaign Finance in Candidate Elections Charter amendment by adding Chapter 2.10 to Portland City Code. Due to concerns that Charter Chapter 3, Article 3 and this implementing ordinance may violate constitutional protections, the proposed legislation also asks the City Attorney to initiate a validation action pursuant to ORS 33.710(2)(e)-(g) in Multnomah County Circuit Court to determine the regularity and legality of the ordinance.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

There will be financial impacts related to implementation of the Code and ongoing program costs if the ordinance as approved is validated by the courts. The City should anticipate a future request for ongoing personnel and materials and services funding.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The Charter amendment is the result of an initiative petition that qualified for the ballot and was approved by voters.
