

**ORDINANCE No. 189352**

\*Authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to execute an agreement with NW Traffic Control, Inc. not to exceed \$17,034 for Sunday Parkways flagging services and to waive application of City Code Chapter 5.33 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation hosts five Sunday Parkways events requiring traffic control and flagging support each year.
2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation hosted the first Sunday Parkways on the Green Loop in 2018 which required significantly more traffic flagging services than other Sunday Parkways events.
3. Through an oversight, these services were not procured in accordance with the correct procedure. The services were nonetheless provided in good faith.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost for this expenditure is high.
5. Funding for this expenditure is included in the Bureau's FY 2018/2019 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

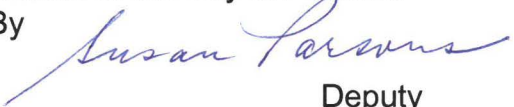
- a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute an agreement with NW Traffic Control, Inc. not to exceed \$17,033.69 for Sunday Parkways flagging services. Application of Portland City Code Chapter 5.33 is waived as to this procurement of services.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay would result in further delayed payment to the vendor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
