Legislation title: *Authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to execute an agreement with NW Traffic Control, Inc. not to exceed \$17,033.69 for Sunday Parkways flagging services and to waive application of City Code Chapter 5.33 (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- The Portland Bureau of Transportation hosts five Sunday Parkways events around the city each year.
- The Portland Bureau of Transportation hosted the city's first Sunday Parkways on the Green Loop in Portland's central city.
- The 2018 Sunday Parkways on the Green Loop event required significantly more traffic control than other Sunday Parkways events and required more traffic flagging services to ensure the safety of participants.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

- No fiscal impact. The cost of traffic control support is part of Sunday Parkways operational budget and this does not amend the budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

- Providing additional traffic control support including additional flaggers for the Sunday Parkways on the Green Loop event helped ensure the safety of people walking, biking and engaging along the route as well as the safety of people driving near the route, including transit operators.
