• Purpose of this ordinance is to increase the authorized amount for PBOT Price Agreement Contract 30005277 with CH2M Engineers, Inc. in order to complete the design for the Outer Division Multi-Modal Safety Project. PBOT has expanded the scope of this project to include additional and necessary safety improvements which include signalized pedestrian crossings, pedestrian scaled street lighting and raised center medians along the Outer Division corridor.
