ORDINANCE No. 189366

*Authorize grievance settlement between AFSCME Local 189 and the City of Portland through its Portland Police Bureau regarding police desk clerks (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On November 15, 2012 AFSCME Local 189 filed a grievance involving the City's use of police officers to perform police desk clerk duties.
- 2. The parties now desire to compromise and settle the grievance. A copy of the proposed Settlement Agreement is attached as Exhibit A.
- 3. Under the terms of the Settlement Agreement:
 - a. Effective July 1, 2019 the City will not use sworn police officers or non-represented employees to perform police desk clerk duties when there is a vacancy for a police desk clerk position, except when there is an active recruitment;
 - b. The City will compensate current City employees who were police desk clerks during the relevant time period (November 15, 2012 to the effective date of the Settlement Agreement, November 14, 2018) for lost voluntary overtime opportunities in the amount of \$500 per employee. There are 16 affected employees; the total amount to be paid is \$8,000.00.
 - c. The union will withdraw the grievance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Human Resources is authorized to enter into and execute the Settlement Agreement in the form attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A, subject to approval as to form by the Office of the City Attorney.
- b. The Police Bureau shall execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in paragraph 3.b. above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
