

Ordinance No. 18705

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to draw warrants to provide for the refund of amounts paid on account of assessments levied for the opening, laying out and establishing of Portland Boulevard.

WHEREAS, on account of being unable to collect delinquent assessments, there being no bids received on the property offered for sale, and it being impossible to draw warrants for the payment of damages to parties entitled thereto, and

WHEREAS, the period of nine months has elapsed since the time limited for appeal and said proceedings are null and void, as provided by Section 358 of the Charter of the City of Portland; therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to draw warrants in favor of the parties who have paid assessments on account of the opening, laying out and establishing of Portland Boulevard from the east line of Vancouver Avenue to the west line of Union Avenue, under the provisions of Ordinance No.

17092 in the sum of \$172.17, said warrants to be drawn in favor of the following named persons for the amounts set opposite their names, respectively:
