ORDINANCE No. 189375 As Amended

Authorize grievance settlement between Portland Police Association and the City of Portland through its Portland Police Bureau regarding terminated employee Gregg Lewis (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau (PPB) terminated employee Gregg Lewis on February 2, 2018. The Portland Police Association ("PPA") grieved the termination. The City denied the grievance and the PPA advanced the grievance to arbitration.
- The parties now desire to compromise and settle the grievance. A copy of the proposed Settlement Agreement is attached as Exhibit A.
- 3. Under the terms of the Settlement Agreement:
 - a. Lewis's termination will be rescinded, and in its place, a 120-hour unpaid suspension will be imposed.
 - b. Lewis will be paid back pay from February 2, 2018, through December 3, 2018, less the amount of a 120-hour suspension without pay, subject to all applicable State and Federal tax withholdings. The amount of back pay, with the 120-hour suspension without pay deducted, and before deduction of applicable withholdings, is \$100.020.53.
 - c. Lewis will permanently retire from City employment effective December 3, 2018. As part of the grievance settlement, Lewis will not apply for and will not be eligible for any Portland Police Bureau or City employment in the future.
 - d. PPA agrees to withdraw the grievance with prejudice.
- 4. PPB and the City Attorney's Office recommend acceptance of the proposed settlement.
- 5. Per PCC 3.15.050, the Director of the Bureau of Human Resources has reviewed and approved the proposed settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor, the Police Chief and the Director of the Bureau of Human Resources are authorized to enter into and execute the Settlement Agreement in the form attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A, subject to approval as to form by the Office of the City Attorney.
- b. The Police Bureau shall execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in paragraph 3.b. above.
