

ORDINANCE No. 189376 As Amended

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$2.2 million from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Brentwood Darlington Safe Routes to School Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation applied to Metro as part of the 2019- 21 Regional Flexible Funds program for a federal grant in the amount of \$2,200,000 for design engineering and construction of the Brentwood-Darlington Safe Routes to School Project in 2017; and
2. The Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the Portland Bureau of Transportation that it will award a grant for the design and construction of the Brentwood-Darlington Safe Routes to School Project to Portland Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$2,200,000;
3. The Portland Bureau of Transportation will over match the grant with an additional \$4,000,000 from the Transportation System Development Charge fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Brentwood-Darlington Safe Routes to School Project in the amount of \$2,200,000 and the Commissioner in Charge to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is in the public interest to receive the grant as quickly as possible; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
