Legislation title: Amend contract with OIR Group for the review of closed officer-involved shooting and in-custody death investigations to extend term and increase maximum compensation allowed under contract by \$60,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30005510)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Ordinance will amend the City's contract with the OIR Group to review closed officer-involved shooting and in-custody death investigation to extend the length of the contract to January 31, 2020 and increase maximum compensation allowed under the contract by \$60,000 to a maximum compensation allowed under the contract to \$200,000.

City Code 3.21.070 L requires the Independent Police Review to hire an outside expert to review closed-officer involved shooting and in-custody death investigations. Since 2003, ten reports by outside experts have been released leading to significant changes in the Police Bureau's investigative process of officer-involved shootings and in-custody deaths.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Contract amendment will increase maximum compensation allowed under contract by \$60,000. Contract amendment will have no budget impact. Funding for OIR Group contract, as amended is included in Independent Police Review requested FY 2019-2020 budget.

No positions will be created, eliminated, or re-classified in the current year or in future years.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The contract amendment will allow additional reviews of closed officer-involved shootings and in-custody deaths and a timelier analysis and critique of Portland's investigative practices.
