## **ORDINANCE No.** 189378

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement to accept and appropriate Metro grant of \$32,000 to support waste reduction efforts at Community Collection Events in the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) partners with Metro to assist Portland Community Collection Events in the form of grant agreements with six Neighborhood District Coalitions (Ordinance No. 183885) and one Interagency Agreement.
- Metro notified the City that Metro will award a grant for continued funding to support mutual regional and citywide goals for improved efforts in waste reduction and proper disposal of bulky household waste that may be disposed of inappropriately.
- 3. This is a one-year grant to December 31, 2019.
- 4. No City match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City, a \$32,000 grant from Metro to support waste reduction efforts at Community Collection Events in the City and to execute an IGA in a form substantially similar to Exhibit 1.
- b. The FY 2018-19 budget is hereby amended as below.

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The BPS Director is authorized to accept, on behalf of the City, any subsequent modifications to the IGA, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
