## **ORDINANCE No.** 189386

Amend contract with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for professional engineering services for the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Waste Gas Burner Replacement Project No. E10649, in the amount of \$338,935 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30005983)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 188379, passed by Council on May 24, 2017 authorized Contract No. 30005983 with Brown and Caldwell Inc. (B&C) for engineering services for the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP) Waste Gas Burner Replacement, BES Project No. E10649 in the amount of \$293,939.
- 2. The initial project scope included replacing the existing waste gas burners in their current location, however it was determined in the predesign phase that it is not possible to replace them in the current location and also meet code and safety requirements. Installing new burners at a new location will allow for more efficient technology to be installed in a manner that meets all current code and safety requirements.
- 3. This amendment provides for compensation for additional scope of work and extends the term of the contract.
- 4. The original contract provided for \$92,000, or 31.3% of total contract dollars awarded to state certified Disadvantaged, Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses (DMWESB). This amendment will increase overall participation dollars to \$198,013 of the total contract dollars to DMWESB subconsultants.
- 5. This amendment will increase the original contract by \$338,935 resulting in a total contract amount of \$632,874. Funding for the project is available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018-19 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS E10649.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 30005983 with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. as outlined in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
