

# INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY ~ MEETING ~

International Women's Day is a historic day of struggle for women's rights, and had its origin in United States in 1908 when working women set aside a special day for agitation for women's suffrage.

The working women are doubly exploited and the economic depression has forced greater burdens on them than ever before. In the factories, laundries, stores, on relief jobs, women work long hours, with more speed-up and receive less wages than the already inadequate wage level of the men. Many pregnant and sick women are denied necessary hospitalization and are at the mercy of miserable charity institutions. Many women are forced into prostitution because they are denied work or adequate relief.

International Women's Day is a day of protest against increased misery, fascism and war and for equal rights for women and unemployment and social insurance.
