We just became aware that there is new oil train infrastructure being built at a plant called Zenith, in Linnton. They have been using this facility to offload trains carrying tar sands oil from Canada for about six months, and the facility is now undergoing an expansion which certainly is not in the spirit of the resolution banning new fossil fuel infrastructure (and pending ordinance) passed in 2017 by the Council.


