Section 1. The Council finds:


1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is correcting the salary grade of the Occupational Health Specialist from Grade 58 to Grade 59.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Effective December 13, 2018, the Occupational Health Specialist job classification salary grade shall be 59.
