

ORDINANCE No. 189414

*Amend contracts with VanderHouwen & Associates, Inc. and Triad Technology Group for staff augmentation in the amount of \$2.5 million each (Ordinance; amend Contract Nos. 31000694 and 31000697)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) currently contracts with local vendors, VanderHouwen & Associates and Triad Technology Group to provide labor in the form of on-call temporary support personnel on an as needed basis to supplement City staff during peak installation or deployment periods and for back-filling of permanent BTS staff.
2. Due to several large-scale projects, such as the Portland Building Project and Portland Online Permitting System (POPS) implementation, the need for staff augmentation services through VanderHouwen & Associates and Triad Technology Group were heavily utilized.
3. Ongoing work that will utilize staff supplied by VanderHouwen & Associates and Triad Technology Group includes augmentation of the server infrastructure team, the enterprise database team, the network team, technology customer support, software maintenance and development, and Portland Building technology support.
4. In order for BTS to continue ongoing, temporary project work using existing contract staff with VanderHouwen & Associates and Triad Technology Group additional funds are required in the amount of \$2,500,000 for each contract. For VanderHouwen & Associates, the new not-to-exceed amount will be \$6,332,000; for Triad Technology Group, the new not-to-exceed amount will be \$6,332,000.. Funds are available in the FY 2018-19 budget.
5. Current contracts No. 31000694 and No. 31000697 expire on March 31, 2020. A competitive solicitation will be conducted in 2019 to establish new staff augmentation contracts beginning no later than April 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute both contract amendments, substantially similar to attachments A & B, provided they are approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to continue work on City technology projects in progress. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council.
