ORDINANCE No. 189418

Adopt findings of City Engineer regarding the appeal of Kyle Bell against the Portland Bureau of Transportation posting property at 2370 SE 60th for sidewalk repairs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On February 28, 2018, the Applicant filed a remonstrance of assessment made for sidewalk and curb repairs at 2370 SE 60th.
- 2. On May 11, 2018, the City Engineer provided a report and review of the remonstrance in accordance with Portland City Code 17.28.160 A. 1-3 detailing the factual background surrounding the sidewalk and curb repair assessment. The report was filed with the Auditor and sent to the Applicant.
- 3. On October 30, 2018, the Applicant filed a notice of appeal with Lee Munson, Portland Bureau of Transportation Sidewalk Maintenance Supervisor.
- 4. In accordance with Portland City Code 17.28.160 A., the City Council held a duly noticed public hearing on January 30, 2019 and issued its Findings on January 30, 2019. The City Council recommended denial of the requested appeal and directed PBOT to come to Council with an Ordinance to codify the findings and determination.
- 5. Based on the findings contained in the City Engineer's Report and testimony during the January 30, 2019 City Council hearing, the City Council denied Applicant's appeal and accepted the City Engineer's report.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council finds:

- a. That the sidewalk repair work at 2370 SE 60th Street was required by Portland City Code 17.28.020.
- b. That the conditions on the sidewalk required the improvements.
- c. That the improvements are consistent with City Code and City specifications as outlined in the City Engineer's Report.

- d. That the improvement charges as outlined in the City Engineer's Report are provided by Portland City Code.
- e. No further adjustments to the charges are necessary because PBOT has already made an adjustment in the bill in accordance with the City Engineer's Report.
- f. The City Engineer shall place the assessment on the City's Sidewalk Repair Assessment Register.

In accordance with Portland City Code 17.28.160 B. Appellant may appeal this decision to the court by Writ of Review.
