Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The proposed legislation will amend the Mandatory Relocation Assistance Policy to make necessary technical changes to reconcile city landlord tenant policy with recently adopted state landlord tenant law, to make other technical changes, and to clarify the affordable housing exemption.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

There are no additional impacts on the city budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The reconciliation of this policy with recently adopted state landlord tenant law will mean continued effects on renters and landlords.
