ORDINANCE No. 189430

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Luther Road Restoration Project No. E10854 for the estimated amount of \$1,750,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
 - 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) will construct the Luther Road Restoration project to stabilize Johnson Creek to prevent further erosion and to protect City infrastructure by achieving the goals of the Johnson Creek Restoration Plan, endorsed by City Council in 2001. In 2015, a series of large storm events caused severe erosion and caused the creek to move laterally in several places. The project will protect the exposed 76-inch Lents Sewer Interceptor where it crosses Johnson Creek; restore habitat and provide upstream passage for sensitive, threatened and endangered (STE) species including anadromous salmon; and improve water quality from two stormwater outfalls.
 - 2. Environmental Services has procured easements, prepared plans and specifications for constructing the project.
 - 3. The established cost is \$1,750,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2019-20 Capital Improvement Plan, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10854.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$1,750,000.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
