ORDINANCE No. 189432 As Amended

*Amend Transportation Fee Schedule to charge fees associated with the Master Lease Agreement and wireless small cell permits and associated fees (Ordinance; amend TRN-3.450)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City, through the Bureau of Transportation ("PBOT") which manages the right-of-way, permits public and private utilities to deliver essential services such as water, electricity and internet access to Portlanders using the right-of-way.
- 2. Utilities that profit from using the public right of way should offer fair value in return.
- 3. The fees determined by the City will ensure that the cost of deployment for small wireless facilities ("SWF") will not rely on taxpayer support.
- 4. The City uses the public right-of-way to improve and protect the public health, safety and welfare of Portlanders and increase first responder efficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That TRN-3.450 - Transportation Fee Schedule be amended to reflect the fees shown on the attached Exhibit A. The amended fees are <u>underlined</u> and can be found in the 'Street Opening (SO) Permits to Utilities' section under 'Small Cells' on page three (3) of the exhibit, as well as in the 'Public Right-of-Way Use Permits – Long Term' section under 'Small Cell Site Lease Program' on page four (4).

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the amendment of the Fee Schedule may result in a delay in the issuance of permits; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
