Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the NE Broadway & 94th Pump Station Upgrade Project No. E10783 for an estimated construction cost of \$1.2 million (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to upgrade the NE Broadway & 94th Pump Station to meet current BES standards, and to provide long-term reliability of conveying municipal wastewater in the collection system.
- 2. The established cost is \$1,200,000. The level of confidence in the estimate is high. This estimate is performed at 90 percent design. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2018- 2019 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10783.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$1,200,000.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
