

ORDINANCE No. 189441

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the North Rivergate Freight Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In June 2018 the City Council entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Port of Portland and ODOT for the North Rivergate Freight Project. The project funding included \$11,651,000 in Federal Funds.
2. In March 2019 the Commissioner in Charge approved an amendment to the IGA that increase the federal share of the project to \$17,836,000 and increased the total project cost estimate to \$26,158,000
3. Project design is completed and PBOT is ready to proceed with bidding the project for construction.
4. PBOT has funds budgeted in FY 18/19 and 19/20 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as plans, specifications, and estimates are now completed, and the project is ready for bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to enter into a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.


