Transmitted herewith as Exhibit A is the 1997 Downtown Parking Meter District Rate Report. This report provides for the increase in downtown parking meter rates from \$.90 per hour to \$1.00 per hour.

The Portland Office of Transportation has been working with a downtown advisory committee since June 1997 to examine a variety of parking meter district issues, including the feasibility of raising the parking meter rates by 10 cents per hour.

The rate report contains the following key recommendations:

- 1) Increase the downtown parking meter rates by 10 cents per hour, effective February 1, 1998
- 2) The incremental increase in parking meter revenue accrued as a result of the 10 cent per hour increase should be allocated in the following manner:
 - To support the extension of Fareless Square to Lloyd District
 - Ongoing marketing to promote multi-modal access and mobility to and around the downtown;
 - Rehabilitation of the downtown transit mall
 - Additional trash receptacles other than those on the transit mall
- 3) Develop and implement a plan to change 60-minute meters to 90 minutes
