## ORDINANCE No.

\* Pay property damage lawsuit of John Arehart in the sum of \$35,000 involving Portland Bureau of Environmental Services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. John Arehart, through attorney Timothy J. Calderbank, has filed a property damage lawsuit against the City for damages suffered in a sewer backup involving the Portland Bureau of Environmental Services on October 31, 2015.
- 2. The lawsuit has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services and the City Attorney's office recommend the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$35,000, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$35,000 made payable to Landerholm PC Client Trust Account.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this property damage lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
