## ORDINANCE No. 189448

\* Pay property damage and bodily injury claims of Mijung Unversagt in the sum of \$40,485 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Mijung Unversagt, through attorney Elliot M.S. Yi and insurance carrier Progressive Insurance, has filed a property damage and bodily injury claims against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau on July 27, 2017.
- 2. The claims have been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise these claims at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claims be compromised for the total sum of \$40,485.66 subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$10,485.66 made payable to Progressive Insurance.
- The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$30,000 made payable to Law Office of Elliot M.S. Yi.
- c. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling these property damage and bodily injury claims; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
