## ORDINANCE No. 189451 As Amended

\*Amend City Code to increase the Chief Procurement Officer's contracting authority and to streamline the procurement and contracting process (Ordinance; amend Code Chapters 5.33 and 5.68)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance 188527, passed by City Council on July 20, 2017, increased the Chief Procurement Officer's contracting authority from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000 for public contracts for goods and services (Chapter 5.33) and construction (Chapter 5.34), and increased the Chief Procurement Officer's contracting authority from \$100,000 to \$500,000 for professional services contracts (Chapter 5.68).
- 2. On December 5, 2018, City Council approved Ordinance 189274 to extend the Chief Procurement Officer's increased contracting authority until March 31, 2019 to allow for the completion of a more comprehensive review of Portland City Code for Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68 by Procurement Services and its bureau customers.
- 3. The Chief Procurement Officer's increased contracting authority under ordinances 188527 and 189274 has reduced contract processing times and increased cost savings. Consequently, City bureaus have advocated for amendments to City Code to permanently increase the Chief Procurement Officer's contracting authority.
- 4. In accordance with City policy, the City Attorney's Office reviewed Procurement Service's revisions to Chapters 5.33 and 5.68.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Amend Portland City Code Chapters 5.33 and 5.68 as shown in Exhibit A, *Amendments to Chapter 5.33.040 and Exhibit B, Amendments to Chapter 5.68.035.* 

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in approval of this Ordinance will interrupt the City's procurement process, interfere with the City's business operations, and degrade the City's public services. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
