Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to approve a revision of Procurement Code Chapters 5.33 and 5.68 to allow the Chief Procurement Officer to execute contracts as allowed by the revised Code which was largely approved by this Council through Ordinance 188527 in July 2017 and extended in December 2018.

No revenues will be impacted by this legislation.

This legislation does not change existing City policy.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

There is no direct budgetary impact based on this legislation.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The contracting community, including contractors certified with the State of Oregon as Disadvantaged, Minority, Women, or Emerging Small Businesses (D/M/W/ESB) have been positively impacted by the changes made as it has allowed for much faster execution of contracts and a resulting increase in cash flow and project turn-around as work has been able to progress much faster.
