

ORDINANCE No. 189462

Amend the code governing the Bureau of Emergency Management, Disaster Policy Council, and Emergency Management Steering Committee to reflect greater citywide engagement in emergency management (Ordinance; amend Code Chapters 3.124, 3.125 and 3.126)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) exists to provide centralized leadership and coordination of emergency management.
2. The Disaster Policy Council (DPC) exists to promote inter-bureau cooperation that furthers the City's emergency management goals.
3. The Emergency Management Steering Committee (EMSC) exists to support PBEM in developing emergency management plans and policies.
4. PBEM provides staff support to the DPC and EMSC and works with them to promote collaborative efforts that advance the City's resilience to disasters and emergencies.
5. PBEM may be supervised by the Mayor or by another Commissioner that the Mayor designates.
6. Bureaus including the Joint Office of Homeless Services, the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services, and the Bureau of Technology Services are recognized as increasingly important to emergency management, and should be represented on the DPC and EMSC.
7. The Housing Bureau does not often play an essential role in emergency response, although it is essential to disaster recovery.
8. At their July 27, 2018 meeting the DPC directed PBEM to amend City Code to reflect these roles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Portland City Code Chapters 3.124, 3.125 and 3.126 are amended as set forth in Exhibit A.


