Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of Hillsdale South Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No₂E10681 for an estimated cost of \$2,065,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate approximately 7,200 feet of sewer main line in the southwest neighborhoods of northern Multnomah and southern Hillsdale.
- 2. The Bureau Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The established cost is \$2,065,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 19-20 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, WBS Element E10681

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$2,065,000.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
