ORDINANCE No. 18945

* Pay settlement of personal injury lawsuit from Angela Branford in the sum of \$50,000 involving the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Angela Branford, through attorney Daniel Snyder, has filed a personal injury lawsuit against the City for damages resulting from a Portland Police Bureau investigation occurring in 2015 and 2016.
- The lawsuit has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The
 investigation indicates there is risk of exposure to the City. Therefore,
 in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent
 to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$50,000, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$50,000 made payable to Angela Branford and the Law Office of Daniel Snyder.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this personal injury lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
