

ORDINANCE No. 189476

Amend a grant agreement with LifeWorks Northwest in an amount not to exceed \$210,000 and extend funding through June 30, 2020, for the New Options for Women program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32001416)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Police Bureau's Sex Trafficking Unit (STU), now part of the Detective Division Human Trafficking Unit (HTU), is a program designed to reduce crime and improve the lives of people caught in the cycle of addiction and criminality. This comprehensive strategy combines resources from the Portland Police Bureau (PPB), the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office (MCDA), and treatment providers;
2. The City contracts with LifeWorks NW (LNW) to support their New Options for Women (NOW) program. This program provides trauma-informed care to females in Portland to help them exit the sex industry;
3. The City wishes to amend existing Contract No. 32001416 with Lifeworks NW to add \$210,000 for the New Options for Women program; and
4. This amendment will extend the term of the Grant Agreement through June 30, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 32001416 between the City and LNW as outlined in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police, their designate, or the Program Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.
