**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

The City has authorized IGAs with PSU for years to administer and implement the Portland Event Recycling Program. The Program provides essential loaner equipment, technical support and educational resources to event coordinators to ensure that Portland residents and visitors have the opportunity to recycle and, as appropriate, compost food scraps at large, medium and small public events throughout the City. The Ordinance authorizes the IGA for 2019-2022.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

The Ordinance authorizes an IGA with Portland State University for 2019-2022 in the amount of \$168,654. Funds in the current year are available in the Solid Waste Management Fund, FY 2018-19 budget, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability. Funds have been or will be requested for the remainder of the Agreement and included in the FY 2019-20, FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 Bureau of Planning and Sustainability budget.

**Community impacts and community involvement:**

The purpose of the IGA is to support event coordinators through providing direct technical assistance, how to materials, instructional signage and easy access to recycling (and food scrap) collection container equipment. Providing Portlanders and visitors with the opportunity to recycle at an event is a public benefit that helps to increase the City's overall waste recovery rate, enhance livability and build a sense of goodwill and community.
