ORDINANCE No. 189490

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the South Portland - Burlingame Phase 1 Sewer Rehabilitation Project No₂E10680, for an estimated cost of \$2,112,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate 3,700-ft of sanitary and combined sewer pipe primarily in the South Portland and Burlingame areas that is in severely deteriorated condition.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The established cost is \$2,112,000. The level of confidence in the estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 19-20 and FY 20-21 Budgets. Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10680.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest a. responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$2,112,000.
- The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer b. System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
