Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This legislation amends Intergovernmental Agreement (Agreement) 30005612 in order to reimburse the Multnomah County Office of the District Attorney for half of their Forensic Consultant's (FC) contractual time for their work on PPB Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) cases. The FC will provide advice and support to the District Attorney's Offices and LEAs in Multnomah, Marion, and Lane Counties regarding the analysis of the USAKs, Combined DNA Index System (CODIS) eligibility, investigation, victim communication, and trial preparation. The FC participates in the establishment of policies and procedures governing the use of forensic evidence in criminal proceedings in Multnomah County.

The grant funding comes from the City's FY16 SAKI Supplemental grant program, which ends March 31, 2020.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

There are no financial or budgetary impacts with this legislation. The Office of Justice Programs (OJP) will reimburse the City for the \$99,000.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The Portland Police Bureau collaborates with government agencies and community organizations that provide access to advocacy services to victims of sexual assaults. There is broad national support for testing every kit and the federal government is providing funding and research for this issue. There are no known objections to this program.
