S.E.R.A. Project 26-B2-20, S.W. Barbur Blvd. Drainage

Relative to S.W. Barbur Boulevard Drainage Tunnel, the division of the State Highway Department, which is overseeing the physical work on this tunnel project, very strongly recommend that this project be worked continuously, that is 24 hours per day and 7 days per week, for only in this way is it possible to make appreciable progress toward the completion of this project. We concur in the recommendation above stated and very strongly urge that every effort be made to have the labor set up so that the work may be carried on continuously.
