ORDINANCE NO. 189536

* Authorize application to Oregon Department of Transportation in the amount of \$150,000 for the Parkrose Neighborhood Center City project as part of the 2019 Transportation Demand Management Grant Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland City Council shares ODOT's goals to support community efforts to expand transportation choices.
- Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) staff have reviewed the grant programs, coordinated with other City bureaus and agencies, and obtained letters of support for the grant proposal.
- BPS seeks a multi-year grant of \$150,000 for the Parkrose Neighborhood Center project. Local match in the amount of \$75,000 will be provided in the form of staff salary, benefits, and material and services from BPS budget in FY19/20 through 20/21. Additionally, a local match of \$18,000 will be paid to ODOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to ODOT for the above referenced grant(s) in the total amount of \$150,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant application must be submitted no later than June 6, 2019. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


