

ORDINANCE No. 189540

* Pay property damage claims of Tim and Marianne Leipzig in the amount of \$28,445 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving the Bureau of Development Services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Tim and Marianne Leipzig have filed property damage claims against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Bureau of Development Services on December 13, 2018.
2. The claims have been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claims at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claims be compromised for the total sum of \$28,445.19 with \$18,974.81 still due, subject to the claimants providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$6,084.20 made payable to Tim Leipzig.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$6,084.20 made payable to Marianne Leipzig.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$6,806.41 made payable to Dick's Collision Center.
- d. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling these property damage claims; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
