Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- This Ordinance will allow for an amendment to the existing Passport Labs, Inc. (formerly known as Passport Parking, Inc.) Contract to provide funding for PP&R to utilize the services within the Contract.
- Passport Labs, Inc. is the vendor for the ParkingKitty app utilized by motorists parking onstreet and in Washington Park.
- The use of ParkingKitty in Washington Park was not anticipated in the original Contract value. Therefore, the most efficient and cost-effective use of City resources is to consolidate the services under one City contract and increase the total value of the contract.
