

ORDINANCE No. 189544 As Amended

*Adopt Administrative Rules for Chapter 2.16 Open and Accountable Elections Program

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Council adopted the Open and Accountable Elections program in December 2016.
2. The intention of the program is to (1) allow candidates to engage with individuals from a variety of backgrounds and neighborhoods, which will ensure that the priorities and concerns of all individuals have the opportunity to be heard, and (2) increase the participation of all Portlanders by increasing the value of small donations.
3. Administrative rules are necessary to clarify the program's requirements and regulations.
4. The creation and refinement of administrative rules have involved key community stakeholders, including members of the Open and Accountable Elections Commission

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City to adopt Administrative Rules for Chapter 2.16 Open and Accountable Elections Program as shown in Exhibit A.
- b. The administrative rules, as shown in Exhibit A, are binding city policy.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is in the public interest to have these rules in effect when the program opens on July 1, 2019; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
