ORDINANCE No. 189548

Increase fee schedule for the Office of Community & Civic Life Noise Office for noise variance applications in the amount of 5% as permitted by Code Section 18.14.020.B (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Office of Community & Civic Life Noise Program manages the City's noise regulations and educates the community about the benefits of the sounds of the City while permitting vibrant events and construction within Portland communities.
- 2. The fees charged by the Office of Community & Civic Life partially fund the Noise Program but are not intended to provide full cost recovery for the critical service of enforcing Title 18 Noise Regulations.
- 3. The fees provided in Exhibit A include a 5% increase to the Noise fees.
- 4. The Noise Review Board, which is composed of community and industry representatives, reviewed and supported the fee changes referenced in this ordinance.
- 5. The changes to the fees provided in Exhibit A are required to reach the budgetary goals for Fiscal Year 2019-20.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Fee Schedule attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance shall be effective July 1, 2019.
- b. Exhibit A to this ordinance is adopted as binding City policy.
