## ORDINANCE No. 189554

Create three new represented classifications of Office Support Specialist Assistant, Maintenance Assistant, Maintenance Assistant-CL and establish an interim compensation rate for each classification. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:
Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is creating three new represented classifications effective July 1, 2019.
2. The business needs that these classifications are intended to meet cannot be fulfilled until the classification and wage rate is established. However, the wage rate for Office Support Specialist Assistant and Maintenance Assistant, must be collectively bargained with AFSCME. Under Article 27.5 .2 of the DCTU contract, the City may establish interim rates during bargaining. The wage rate for the Maintenance Assistant-CL must be collectively bargained with Laborers' 483 . Under Article 27.5.2 of the contract, the City may establish interim rates during bargaining.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:
a. The following classifications are being created, effective July 1, 2019:

Job Class
Office Support Specialist Assistant
Maintenance Worker Assistant Maintenance Worker Assistant-CL
b. The following interim compensation rate is established:

Office Support Specialist Assistant:

Maintenance Worker Assistant and Maintenance Worker Assistant-CL:
$\begin{array}{lll}\text { Entry } & \frac{6 \text { Months }}{} \quad \frac{1 \text { Year }}{\$ 12.50} & \$ 14.44\end{array} \frac{\$ 16.37}{}$
c. When the City along with AFSCME and Laborers' 483 conclude necessary bargaining over the appropriate salary rates, the rates may be implemented with no further action upon signing of a Memorandum of Agreement between the Director of Human Resources
and AFSCME and Laborers' 483 and approval as to form by the Office of the City Attorney.
