# Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The ordinance must be passed by Council to prepare the City for the beginning of a new fiscal year on July 1, 2019. This item is included because ORS 221.770 requires the City to formally elect to accept state shared revenues.

#### Financial and budgetary impacts:

The ordinance makes the City eligible for an estimated \$22,466,522 in cigarette, liquor, and state marijuana taxes in FY 2019-20.

## Community impacts and community involvement:

As bureaus developed their requested budgets, they each engaged a Budget Advisory Committee composed of public and employee members. A five-member Community Budget Advisory Board was invited to sit in on budget discussions with the Mayor and Council as the budget was developed. In addition, numerous public hearings were held throughout the budget process. Public testimony on the budget was accepted in person, in writing, and online.
