

ORDINANCE No. 189562

*Accept a \$6,719,841 grant from Oregon Department of Transportation and authorize Intergovernmental Agreement for the City of Portland Safety Projects (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In 2012, the federal transportation bill Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act was signed into law, which increased transportation safety funding; and
2. Utilizing this increased safety funding, the Oregon Department of Transportation created the All Roads Transportation Safety (ARTS) Program in 2013 to reduce fatal and serious injuries on all public roads through a data driven process; and
3. Portland Bureau of Transportation worked with the Oregon Department of Transportation to identify proven, low-cost measures that have successfully reduced the occurrence of fatal and serious injury crashes on Portland streets; and
4. ODOT and PBOT staff have developed a list of nine projects on city streets that meet the criteria and available funds; and
5. ODOT has allocated \$6,719,840.85 of Federal Funds from the All Roads Transportation Safety (ARTS) program for these projects
6. PBOT has committed to match 7.78 percent or \$566,915.00, making the total project cost \$7,286,750.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from ODOT for the City of Portland Safety Projects in the amount of \$6,719,840.85. Any increases to the Grant Amount must be approved by the City Council.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in the amount of \$6,719,840.85 in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's


financial risk.

- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.


