

ORDINANCE No. 106348


An Ordinance granting a permit to Greyhound Rent-A-Car, Inc., a Delaware corporation, by John Barrie, Jr., Western Manager, 371 Market Street, San Francisco, California, to engage in the business of Motor Vehicles for Hire in the city of Portland, waiving certain provisions of Section 20-6303 of Ordinance No. 76398, the License and Business Code, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:


Section 1. The Council finds that Greyhound Rent-A-Car, Inc., a Delaware corporation, authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, by John Barrie, Jr., Western Manager, 371 Market Street, San Francisco, California, has applied for a license to operate a Motor Vehicles for Hire business in the city of Portland with an initial fleet of 15 motor vehicles, and that the application has been approved by the Commissioner of Public Utilities, who recommends that the license be granted, and the Council finds that the provisions of Section 20-6303 of the License and Business Code requiring the signature and recommendation of three property owners within the city before such license can be issued is not appropriate under the circumstances; now, therefore, a permit to Greyhound Rent-A-Car Inc., a Delaware corporation, authorized to do business in the state of Oregon, by John Barrie, Jr., Western Manager, 371 Market Street, San Francisco, California, to maintain and operate a Motor Vehicles for Hire business in the city of Portland, hereby is granted, and the requirement of Section 20-6303, Permit To Engage In Business, of Ordinance No. 76398, the License and Business Code, passed by the Council December 18, 1941, as amended, requiring the prior written recommendation of three property owners within the city attesting to the honesty and integrity and responsibility of the applicant, is waived because of the corporate nature of the applicant making such recommendation inapplicable.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the city of Portland in this: In order that the applicant may be permitted to promptly enter into the business field of Motor Vehicles for Hire in the city of Portland; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


