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# IMPACT STATEMENT

**Legislation title:** Establish Privacy and Information Protection Principles to serve as guidance for how the City of Portland (City) collects, uses, manages, and disposes of Data and Information. (Resolution)

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## Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The City of Portland recognizes that while emergent Data and Information collection and communication technologies have the potential to change Portland in positive ways and to support more participatory government, a real risk exists that the use of these tools may have a negative impact on our communities, particularly on our most vulnerable populations, if privacy and information protection are not prioritized.

By adopting this Resolution, City Council commits to using the Privacy and Information Protection Principles (Exhibit A) ("Principles") when considering policies and projects that require the collection, use, management and disposal of Data and Information. City Council also directs staff at the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability and Office of Equity and Human Rights to work with other City of Portland bureaus to identify and develop a process for creating, reviewing, implementing and strengthening equitable and anti-discriminatory policies and procedures that promote these Principles. This will include determining the staff and budget resources needed to implement this process as part of an overall Data Governance strategy for the City.

## Financial and budgetary impacts:

There is no immediate financial or budget impact that would result from adopting the Privacy and Information Protection Principles (Exhibit A). The Smart City PDX program will likely seek future staff and budget resources needed to implement a process for creating, reviewing, implementing and strengthening equitable and anti-discriminatory policies and procedures that promote the Principles as part of an overall Data Governance strategy for the City.

#### Community impacts and community involvement:

By adopting this Resolution, City Council directs staff at the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability and Office of Equity and Human Rights to make recommendations to assure community involvement in the review of City procedures, practices and policies to assure the full and effective implementation of the Principles.
